



Join our annual fun bike ride for all abilities, featuring 35, 64 and 100 mile loops! Ride one or both days in picturesque countryside around Lake Hartwell and Toccoa, Georgia. This is an official Bicycle Ride Across Georgia 2009 Training Ride!

Beginning and ending in Hartwell, Georgia (adjacent to beautiful Lake Hartwell and the Georgia/South Carolina border), you'll enjoy riding loops that traverse rolling back country roads with picturesque scenery and minimum traffic. Open to cyclists and accomplished skaters!

Come for one day or both! You can camp inside the middle school gym, pitch a tent outside, or stay in one of Hartwell's hotels. Come Friday night and stay until after the ride Sunday. Saturday's ride will take you over the dam on Lake Hartwell – no matter which route you choose! Enjoy this spectacular sight or the simple beauty of the wild roadside roses as you ride the Challenge of the Centuries.

Your entry includes: contribution to the Boy Scouts of America Troop 33 and Hart Partners; a quality 100% cotton t-shirt; nice camping and bath facilities; "Cars & Guitars" entertainment downtown on Saturday night; six scenic & well marked courses to ride; ride maps; sag support; security for your belongings while riding; and a great time with family and friends!

Registration opens at 6:30 AM each day. Pre-registered riders and Friday night campers may also pick-up their packets or register on Friday 7:00-9:00 PM. Riders will be required to sign a release form before riding. Save \$5 if you register before April 30! A t-shirt is not guaranteed for registrations postmarked after Monday, May 17. An ANSI-approved helmet is required.

Directions: Take the Exit 177 off of Interstate I-85 (this is near the GA-SC border), and go south on Hwy. 77 which leads to Hartwell (approximately 12 miles away). In Hartwell, follow U.S. 29 East through town to Campbell Drive (the Northeast Georgia Bank will be on your left) and turn right. Go one block and turn left on Powell Road. Hart County Middle School (the ride start) is on Powell Road on the right.
